ACSI - PSI Certification Visit

We were honoured to receive a visit from a team representing ACSI Southern Africa, led by Brian Bliss, leader of the Paths to School Improvement programme, based at the Rwanda office.

I am pleased to announce that the affirmation team will be recommending to ACSI PSI International that Lendy Park School is ready for its first certification. While we celebrate this achievement, we recognise that it is only a marker on the path of our journey. **We will continue to strive for excellence and to reflect God's truth in all that we do.**

This programme is particularly significant as it offers you, our parent body, confidence in the work we are doing and, more importantly, assurance that the progress made over the past two years will continue, even in light of my impending departure. **The regular recertification required by the programme ensures this continuity.**

The inspection was thorough, covering all aspects of the school, and included interviews with all stakeholders: parents selected by the PA, teachers, students, and support staff.

This programme is the first of its kind among independent schools in Zimbabwe, where participating schools are regularly visited and assessed to ensure that standards are maintained, and any weaknesses within the school systems are addressed.
