Paths to School Improvement (PSI)

Lendy Park has been participating in the PSI programme over the last few years. This programme is run by the Association of Christian Schools (ACSI) Southern Africa and will end with a certification (providing the school meets the required standards) of quality assurance.

Lendy Park has chosen this route to provide the parent body with the secure knowledge that the school meets the required standards academically, spiritually and administratively to be a part of this body of schools (It is similar to the ATS but has a Christian requirement). We have just finished the training to implement the fourth stage of the programme which focused on policy and its implementation. In the coming term, new or updated policies will be rolled out. These policies will be circulated to the PA Committee for feedback before they are finally sent to the Board of Trustees for approval.

This is an ongoing process and we would value your input in this process so that we end up with a set of policies that ensures fairness, transparency and excellence in all that we do.
